A fabulous client and friend decided she wanted to help the counter-sex trafficking movement in some way. As she sat in my advanced class and observed survivors, a forensic traumatologist, and a provider hone their speaking skills so they could better communicate their stories, educate those who can provide helpful resources, and bring awareness of needed solutions to the public, she was moved to action. She wrote to me that night and informed me that she wanted to pay for 50 students a year who were either victims, survivors, providers, and/or advocates in the counter-trafficking movement. She believes the ripple effect will be more significant than if she gave in another way because she saw the difference it is making in the lives of those she witnessed...the confidence, the self-respect, and the power that came with being calm, confident and compelling when they speak. Although I've been able to have some students come through my class on scholarships, this allows me to expand that part of my program significantly, and that's where you can help.

The ability of our staff to effectively support trafficking survivors and to advocate on their behalf has been greatly improved. Thank you for allowing us to be part of the BREE program.





IN THEIR WORDS An Advocate's Experience

The stigma around sex work and sex trafficking is so damaging because it makes it impossible to have open, honest conversations, to talk about the reality of the situation

It has taken me years to be willing to risk speaking publicly about my experiences. I have worried that it would impact my safety, my ability to get a job, to earn my pro card as a bodybuilder, to make friends, to find a partner, to be allowed to exist as a part of society...

Part of my trauma as a trafficking survivor has been keeping it a secret. I've lived a half life, always hiding, suffocating under my shame. My purpose in sharing my experiences is to break the stigma so that I can be my authentic self, and create an environment for you to be your authentic self as well.

I recently completed a mock interview in the advanced speaking class I'm taking with the amazing and talented Zen Speaker, Amy Ayoub, and shared it online. Amy has been helping me move through my shame and learn some techniques so that I can connect with and voice my message.

Kimberly's business is now profitable, and she is sharing her powerful message with others across the United States and Canada. For this training presentation alone, she earned a speaker's fee of \$10,000. In January 2023, she gave her speech in Ft. Worth, TX and it was streamed into the county jails. In just the first day, twelve women came forward to report being trafficking victims.

I spent the week in beautiful Ontario, Canada training law enforcement, social services, medical personnel, and more about human trafficking. I got to visit with professionals across the providence and help them take steps towards long term action plans. I LOVE what I do and am BEYOND blessed by the individuals who have helped make it possible for me to work for myself doing what I love.
